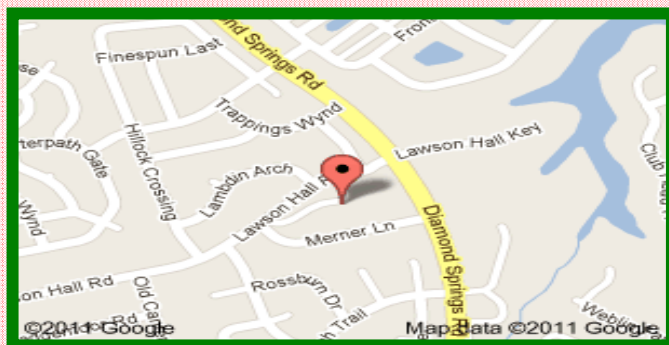

Directions West on I-264 W/Norfolk-Virginia Beach Expy, Take the Newton Rd exit toward I-64 W/Richmond/US-13/Military Hwy, Take the Newtown Rd exit.. Turn right onto Newtown Rd/N Newtown Rd/VA-403. Continue to follow Newtown Rd. Stay straight to go onto Diamond Springs Rd. Turn left onto Lawson Hall Rd. Lawson Hall Rd is 0.2 miles past Virginia Tech Ct. 5525 LAWSON HALL RD is on the left, just past Larder Post. If you reach Lambdin Arch you've gone a little too far.
