Follow the I-264 E/ Norfolk Virginia Beach Expy to 21<sup>st</sup> Street in Virginia Beach. Continue on to 21<sup>st</sup> Street for 0.5 miles. Turn left onto Pacific Avenue, head north on Pacific Avenue for 1.4 miles. Continue onto Atlantic Avenue for 0.2 miles. Turn left onto Cavalier Drive.
