Armed Forces Brewery Tour

On February 20, 2024, members of IFMA gathered at the newly opened Armed Forces Brewery, located at 211 West 24th Street, Norfolk, VA in the Railroad District. The brewery opened in the old O'Connor Brewing Company facility, which closed in 2023. Prior to life as a brewery, the building was used as a food warehouse. Now, with a new paint job, a totally re-vamped tasting room, and a state-of-the-art brewing facility, Armed Forces is making and shipping beer across 15 states, with plans to continue to expand in the future. IFMA was given a guided tour by Head Brewer Dale Lazar, who provided a behind the scenes tour of the facility, a history of the company, and answered questions from members. The group was able to socialize together afterwards on the raised mezzanine level at the middle of the tasting room.
